Description of Duties

In a garage and/or in the field, performs maintenance and repair on gasoline and diesel motor vehicles, including special purpose vehicles and associated equipment, such as trash trucks, tractors, power mowers, snowplows, landscape equipment and shop equipment.

Diagnoses pertinent vehicle operations systems, inoperative motor vehicles and equipment by using available equipment to determine the cause of the malfunction and takes corrective action and perform needed repairs.

Performs other related duties as required.

Requirements:

TRAINING:

Successful completion of training in automotive technology at an accredited college or vocational school.

An Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Certification preferred.

An Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Certification in Brake Repairs.

Air Brake Certification.

EXPERIENCE:

Two (2) years of experience as a mechanic in the repair of gas and diesel engines, and the maintenance and repair of motorized vehicles and equipment, air brakes, hydraulics, electrical systems.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required formal training may substitute with additional years of experience.

Appointees must possess a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) license valid in New Jersey. It is preferred that the appointee possess a valid CDL and applicable endorsements for the classes and types of vehicle being operated in the Borough, at the time of appointment. Any Appointees that does not currently have a CDL will be required to obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and applicable endorsement(s) within 12 months of appointment, at their own expense. The inability of an employee to attain a CDL and necessary endorsements within 12 months of hire shall constitute grounds for removal.
