BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by Borough Council of the Borough of Berlin, in the County of Camden, State of New Jersey on June 11, 2026 and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS 2026 SEWER UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS, BY AND IN THE BOROUGH OF BERLIN, IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$425,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$425,000 BONDS OR NOTES TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF
