2026 BERLIN BOROUGH PROPERTY TAX DISTRIBUTION

Where Your Tax Dollars Go

The accompanying pie chart illustrates how the average Berlin Borough property tax bill is distributed among the various taxing authorities. While the Borough collects the taxes, most of the tax dollars are distributed to schools and Camden County.

Example – Average Berlin Borough Homeowner

Average Residential Assessment: \$237,913

2026 Total Tax Rate: \$3.682 per \$100 of assessed value

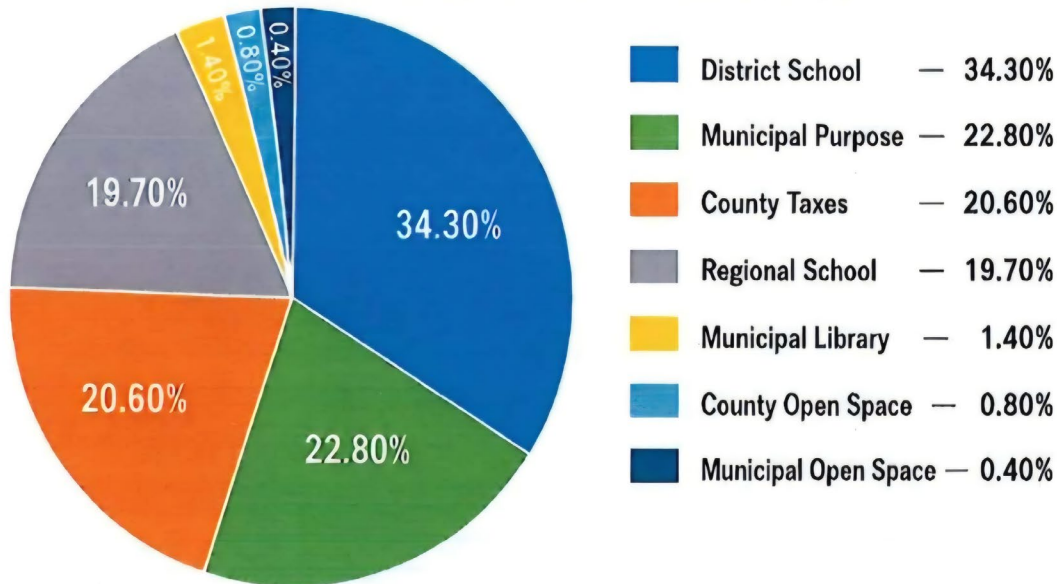

A resident guide to the distribution of the 2026 property tax levy



2026 PROPERTY TAX DISTRIBUTION



Percentages are shown to two decimal places and total 100.00%.



Berlin Borough collects the full property tax payment, but does not keep the entire amount. The levy is distributed among the School District, Camden County, Berlin Borough, and county and municipal open-space funds.

HOW THE MONEY IS USED

- **District School — 34.30%:** Supports the local public school district, including instruction, staff, transportation, facilities, special education, and school operations.
- **Municipal Purpose — 22.80%:** Funds Berlin Borough operations including administration, public works, public safety, tax collection, road maintenance, code enforcement, and other municipal services.
- **County Taxes — 20.60%:** Supports Camden County Government, courts, public safety, roads, health services, elections, and countywide programs.
- **Regional School — 19.70%:** Supports the regional high school district, including instruction, staff, transportation, and school operations.
- **Municipal Library — 1.40%:** Provides funding for the local municipal library.
- **County Open Space — 0.80%:** Supports countywide farmland preservation, parks, and open-space acquisition and maintenance.
- **Municipal Open Space — 0.40%:** Supports local parks, recreation areas, and open-space preservation within Berlin Borough.



AT A GLANCE: 54.00% of the levy goes to the District School and Regional School. 20.60% is allocated to Camden County. The Borough keeps 22.80% for municipal services. County Open Space (0.80%), Municipal Open Space (0.40%), and the Municipal Library (1.40%) account for 2.60%.

Percentages are based on the 2026 Certified Tax Rate as certified by the Camden County Board of Taxation.
